PARASITE FREE

The purpose of this product is to assist the body in purging unwanted visitors from the digestive tract. This means its intention is to cause not only diarrhea, but diarrhea in conjunction with a disconnection of parasites from the intestinal wall (which may result in a small amount of blood). It is important that you expect your pet to have some level of diarrhea and a small amount of blood when using dewormers – it is important to allow this process.

However, it is also important that you do not accept a level of diarrhea that is dehydrating to your pet or a large amount of blood. Ensure that your pet has access to increased amounts of clean water and that you take your pet to the vet if diarrhea or blood becomes excessive with the use of this product or any deworming agent.

DAILY FEEDING



Up to 20lb	1/2 tsp 1-3x per day
21-40lbs	1 tsp 1-3x per day
41-80lbs	1.5 tsp 1-3x per day
over 81lbs	2 tsp 1-3x per day

For first time use, gradually increase into your pet's diet. Start with 1/4th the recommended daily amount and increase over the course of 3 days.

Contraindications: None. This blend can be used in combination with other foods and medications.

The daily feeding amount can be fed split into multiple servings or fed all at once. The amount listed here is a total feeding amount for an entire day, not a feeding suggestion per meal.

INGREDIENTS



Wormwood is one of over 500 species of Artemisia - an herb known for its anti-cancer properties. Wormwood is a strong anti-parasitic, anti-fungal, and antioxidant. As stated previously, parasitic infections and fungal overgrowth can both be root causes of allergic conditions. Even with the addition of anti-inflammatory and immune boosting herbs, the body will continue to have allergic symptoms if the root cause, such as parasite or fungus, is still present.



Witch Hazel is an astringent herb. This means that it contracts tissues in the digestive tract, thus "squeezing out" parasites. Witch Hazel can contribute to the detachment of parasites in the intestines, thus allowing them to be more effectively eliminated from the body.

INGREDIENTS



Wormwood is effective in dealing with internal parasites due to its anti-parasitic compounds, like artemisinin and thujone, which disrupt the cellular functions of parasites, weakening or killing them. It also stimulates digestion by increasing bile production and improving gut motility, making the digestive tract less hospitable for parasites. Additionally, wormwood's anti-inflammatory properties help reduce gut inflammation caused by parasitic infections, promoting healing, while its antimicrobial effects combat other pathogens that may be present.



Holarrhena antidysenterica (Kutaja) is effective due to its bioactive compounds, such as conessine and holarrhenine, which have antimicrobial, astringent, and anti-inflammatory properties. These compounds inhibit the growth of harmful bacteria, soothe the intestinal lining, and reduce inflammation. Its antiparasitic benefits are attributed to its ability to paralyze and expel intestinal parasites by disrupting their cellular functions. Kutaja is traditionally used to treat diarrhea, dysentery, and parasitic infections by promoting a healthy balance in the gut and inhibiting pathogen proliferation.

INGREDIENTS



Vidanga is also known as false black pepper in ayurveda. It is most commonly used to expel worms, parasites, and multidrug resistant pathogens (Klebsiella spp. Proteus spp. Salmonella spp. Citrobacter spp. E.coli, Bacillus spp.) from the stomach. It is beneficial for indigestion and also helps to manage constipation due to its laxative property. Vidanga may also protect the heart against cellular damage of free radicals due to its cardioprotective and antioxidant activities.



Chaparral contains 9 flavonoids with a broad range of biological activity including anti-parasitic activity. Specifically, Chaparral has been shown to be an effective therapeutic option against giardia and mosquito-borne diseases.

celandine

Celandine is known for its ability to:

- Improve jaundice by clearing the bile duct
- Improve liver disease conditions
- Decrease inflammation
- Decrease spastic conditions
- Decrease the instance and symptoms of gallstones
- Affect gram-positive bacteria (e.g. E.coli)
- Affect gram-negative bacteria (e.g. E.coli, Salmonella enteritidis)
- Kill Candida Albicans yeast




peppermint

The parasite-purging process can be very uncomfortable. Peppermint has a highly anesthetic effect on the digestive system - menthol, a chemical component of mint, can have an antispasmodic effect and reduce intestinal inflammation, "soothing" an irritated system.

INGREDIENTS



Diatomaceous Earth is a powdery substance made from tiny creatures called diatoms - microalgae found in waterways and soils. Diatoms are microscopic and have hard, abrasive outer shells. Like a nail file, their tiny sharp edges can “grind down” and “scrape” the exoskeleton of parasites. Once the exoskeleton is damaged, the parasite will dehydrate and die. Meanwhile, soft tissues such as the digestive tract or skin will not be damaged. This makes it an excellent chemical-free anti-parasitic for internal or external use. Diatomaceous Earth is a non-chemical way to kill anything with an exoskeleton. Solutions uses Organic, Food Grade DE



Anise is well known for its digestive benefits and is included in this blend to ease the discomfort caused by the parasite-purging process. Antispasmodic properties of anise can relax the muscles of the gastrointestinal tract, which helps alleviate stomach cramps, discomfort, and colic, as well as decrease discomfort caused by muscle spasming, which is a common occurrence during a parasite purge.

INGREDIENTS



cascara sagrada

Cascara Sagrada Bark is a stimulant laxative. It forces muscle contractions in the intestines. When used in tandem with astringent and anti-parasitic herbs, Cascara Sagrada can help deliver the “final” blow of purging invaders from the intestines. Without Cascara Sagrada, parasites could re-adhere to the intestinal wall and continue to proliferate once the astringent and anti-parasitic herbs have passed.



chicory

Also known as Inulin, Chicory is a prebiotic polysaccharide that feeds and nurtures good bacteria. Probiotics, or good bacteria, are microscopic living organisms that function like healthy gut soldiers in the digestive system. In order for Probiotics to be healthy, happy and capable of putting up a good fight in maintaining the balance of the digestive tract, they must be fed. Prebiotics, like the dietary fiber Inulin in Chicory, provide this food.

INGREDIENTS



Senna contains compounds called sennosides, which stimulate the lining of the bowel, causing it to contract and move waste along the digestive tract more quickly. This increased intestinal movement may help expel parasites, particularly after the parasites have been killed by other compounds.

Senna can also help cleanse the intestines by facilitating the removal of dead parasites and debris, which can aid in recovery and prevent secondary infections.



Slippery Elm is a mucilaginous herb that can help improve conditions of the stomach, intestines, sinuses, and lungs because these areas of the body depend on healthy mucous to function correctly.

Mucous has the ability to encapsulate foreign bodies, including parasites. It has the ability to provide tissues with an opportunity to heal when damaged. Slippery Elm stimulates the nerve endings in the lining of these tissues which then stimulates an increased production of mucous, thus soothing/ calming and healing the area.

FEEDING TIPS

Because Parasite Free is intended to help eliminate unwanted and parasitic visitors in the digestive tract, diarrhea may ensue with the use of this product. A pet may be more susceptible to diarrhea from this blend if they:

- have a particularly large parasite/protozoa load to eliminate
- have a particularly inflamed digestive tract or other digestive issue
- are taking medications that contribute to loose stool

For these reasons, we recommend starting with $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ of the suggested dose only 1-2x/day. If it is well tolerated, increase to 3x/day. If it is well tolerated, increase closer to the suggested dose. Once you are providing the suggested dose in the suggested frequency, continue this blend for 30 days to ensure that the life-cycle (and reproduction) of the parasites is fully treated. Early discontinuation of use for any reason besides negative response could result in re-proliferation of parasites.

Most anti-parasitic herbs and drugs cause a temporary (during use) increase in liver enzymes. Cessation of use of these herbs should decrease liver enzymes back into a normal range. Use of parasite clearing herbs or medications in a pet that already has elevated liver enzymes should be done with care and under the supervision of an educated veterinarian.
